

Club Donation Requirements:

Please make sure the clubs you are donating are in "GOOD USED CONDITION" - meaning they are in good working order and have no damage. Remember that in order to raise money for the Cure, the clubs must be resold as-is (w/ only a quick cleaning) as they are not refurbished or repaired. Clubs not in "good used condition" cannot be deducted (per IRS tax codes). They have no value and will be discarded by Rally for the Cure.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS are that iron sets must include sequential matching heads, shafts and shaft flexes (iron set criteria). In general, golf clubs that are considered "classic" or "antique" (E.g. clubs over 20 yrs old, woods with wooden heads, or clubs with wood/hickory shafts) DO NOT qualify.

CLUBHEADS must have NO dents or dings, pop-up marks, chrome or paint chipping, deep scratches or gouges, damaged or missing branding, rust, or excessive sole or face wear. See Examples

SHAFTS must have NO dents, dings or bends, rust or excessive wear, broken, loose, separated or missing ferrules, or damaged or missing bore-through. See Examples
